2019 HIGHLIGHTS

2019 was a year fully dedicated to constructing the organizational structure and foundations for AMA's future as we head into a new decade. The Volunteer Board dedicated over 15 biweekly virtual meetings to (1) restructuring the volunteer board; (2) writing our organizational bylaws (available to all members upon request); (3) recruiting, interviewing and contracting with a consultant experienced in early-stages, non-profit organizations to work on a strategic plan for the next three years. The recruitment and interview process lasted 5 weeks. The consulting process lasted 3 months: from November 2019 to February 2020. Many thanks to our members who responded to our request for proposal.
