FIRST AMA-WOMEN SUMMIT IN THE CITY OF PUEBLA, MEXICO

The American Mexican Association just held the first meeting of AMA-Women in the city of Puebla, Mexico, in collaboration with the Institute of Mexicans Abroad (IME) and the Puebla Institute of Migrant Assistance (IPAM).

The purpose of this meeting is to connect women leaders in the United States to create new links and communication channels that allow them to collaborate in shared projects, and together design a binational and cross-cutting gender agenda that, among other objectives, consolidates women empowerment and equality as one of the priority items in AMA's agenda.

The American Mexican Association comprises 6 regional coordinations and over 45 cities in the United States. AMA-Women is the second thematic axis in the Association, following the model of AMAYI (AMA-Young Immigrants) which was created last year.

AMA's mission is to promote the economic, social, and cultural contributions of Mexican Americans, Latinos and immigrants to the U.S. In this meeting, AMA welcomed new members from 14 cities across the country.
